- **No more than 2 authors** may participate in the writing of abstracts.
- Materials should be submitted in the volume of **up to 3 pages** of A4 format, text editor - MS Word, Times New Roman font size **12 pt**, single line spacing, paragraph indent - 1.25 cm, all margins of 2 cm.
- The title of the materials shall be formatted as follows:

- The main text follows through the line. Mandatory sections of the scientific publication: Relevance; Purpose of the study; Results of the study and their discussion; Conclusions; List of references.
- Tables, charts and figures are accepted in .pdf, .jpg, .png formats.
- Tables, diagrams and figures should not exceed the specified margins. The size of the font used in the design is not less than 11 pt.

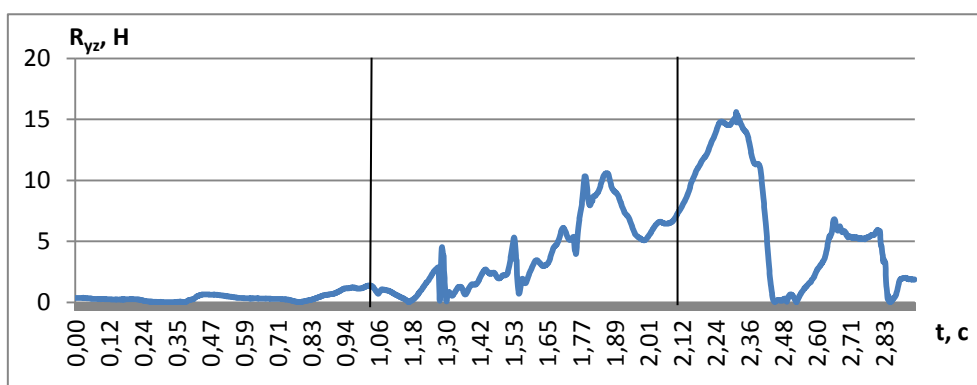


Figure 6 – Dependence of the resultant vector on longitudinal and vertical components from time

GOST R 7.0.100-2018 (the list should contain no more than 5 sources, self-citation - no more than 1 source, no more than 1 source per publication of the scientific supervisor).

References to the literature in the text are given in figures corresponding to the number of the author in the bibliographic list in square brackets:

... Elements of wrestling are recommended for inclusion in physical education lessons, which is reflected by experts in normative documents and the content of school programmes [7].

• The published work should be carefully edited and contain original material not previously printed elsewhere.

• All documents are submitted in one file from the scientific supervisor under the title (Last Name First Name), including:

- materials (abstracts),
- registration form (Annex).
